

Highlights of District Boardmeeting in Salzburg April 17th – 19th, 2015

- Timetable of the Agenda for the District Conference 2015 in Garmisch-Partenkirchen (October 9-11) has been discussed and preliminary adopted.

- Early bird registrations received before June 30, 2015 is € 155,00, registrations received after June 30, 2015 are € 195.- / person. Note: Guests, not participating in the conference pay only for the side events.
- Angelika Stecher has started the nominating process, a reminder to all presidents will make sure that all clubs are involved and discuss the future leadership of the district. The final slate of the candidates will be sent to the clubs according to regulation not later than 60 days prior to the elections.
- The revised *District Rules of Procedure*, *Reimbursement Guidelines* and *Election Rules* with reverence to the new ZI-Bylaws were adopted by the board and sent for reviewing to the Bylaws Chairman Barbara Tramosch. These documents will be included in the Call to Conference for approval.
- Clubs are encouraged to submit motions concerning District 14 or ZONTA International matters to the Bylaws chairman in time to be presented in the Call to conference prior 60 days to the Conference.
- Solidarity fund requests have to be submitted in written to the Governor via Area Director.

 - Contributions to ZI-Foundation have increased the last months
 - Membership is constant
